And now, I am a consultant for the international industries, businesses and commerce as well as media. For example I have given up research and studies chances at some of the best universities of the world incl Harvard, University of Glasgow, University of Paris. Laval University, Tsinghua University etc.

I have given up my political career at the Chinese Central Government at mid 80's.

I have lost my great career at some of the best multinationals such as GE etc because of my damaged voice cord and other reasons.

I didn't accept orders of dozens of millions of EUROS of solar businesses from Germany and other European countries for political reasons.

I didn't set up and develop my own business duo to the same.

I didn't go to the Chinese education system for a career duo to the same reasons and because of the corruption there.

In one word. I used to have had the best and most privileged opportunities in Academic, Political and Business areas, which are only in dreams of the others. **I was once one of the few luckiest people of the world.**

- ▶ I have tried very hard in many fields and with various degrees of success, whether academic, entrepreneurial or political.
 - I was able to go to one of the (top20) universities in China, and
 - after graduation I was able to work at some of the best organizations, institutions and corporations of the world,
 - acquired wide spectrum of knowledge and experience of power, energy, IT and Internet, aviation and other industries,
 - acquired six or seven foreign languages
 - etc.
- ▶ I used to be among the key personnel of some of the leading multinational corporations in China in the nuclear power, conventional power, hydropower and renewable energy industry with varying roles such as marketing, procurement, design and quality assurance as well as management and administration.
- ▶ I was also in several key Chinese organizations, institutions and corporations.
- ▶ With my comprehensive professional background and many skills particularly my work experiences at multinational corporations, I know what the corporate executives, the marketing people, the R&D members, the manufacturing personnel, the logistic teams, the warehouse keepers, and all your people at all levels in your organizations shall know about the market in China, and with an English language very English indeed.
- ▶ I have started several businesses which provided information, consultancy, reporting, trading of the power, energy, and business aviation industries – particularly the solar energy sector to foreign companies. Prior to that, I was engaged in the IT industry by developing several industry portals for Korean companies and private persons in Shanghai.

- ▶ And I am as skilled as a long-time IT engineer with all technologies of web development. And much much more.
- ▶ For my spare time I am doing researches of varying topics ranging from thermodynamics, solar physics, solar radiation, cryptography and mathematics.
- ▶ And now, I am a consultant for the international industries, businesses and commerce as well as media.
- ▶ My interests have now shifted to be the researches of carcinogenetic thermodynamics and related sciences and my business is redirected to the reporting, consultation and services with the coverage of the worldwide luxury market with special focus on China and special area of interests in private jets, luxury yachts, limousines, villas and arts.

- ▶ For the above reasons, I am now living a life quite different from the one I shall have achieved.

6. Three Phases

Phase I: Full Hope (1963-1989, age 0 to 26)

During this time I've mostly devoted to studies and learning. I won a master degree at one of the top universities in China and have climbed to the top of the research at that time in the area of thermo-physics with special interests in air pollution control in combustion process. I have also managed to work at the heart of the Chinese government and was so close to the power center that it was nearly a matter of years to rise to the top of the Chinese political hierarchy. At this period of time I was considered as among the social elites and the best of my colleagues and was quite successful in the eyes of my people around me incl. the people in my hometown.

I was happy and hopeful all time during that period of time.

Phase II Extreme Hopeless (1989-2005, age 26 to 42)

After the Tiananmen "rebellion", I saw no hope in China's future at least for another 20 years, and therefore decided to go abroad. However, the plan was interrupted by my unsuccessful love story with a girl from Taiwan, and all of my life was totally changed due to my giving up of doctoral studies at some of the most prestigious universities of the world. And the hypocrisy of my American friend has forced me to decide not to go to the States and the West and instead I stayed in China to pursue personal wealth. However, the system is so corrupt that I have again decided I won't feed up the corrupt officials by making a large enterprise, and instead I decided to make small money just enough for my living. But still I have planning for doing something really big and tried to implement the plan if China is going to be more and more free. But this turns unlikely in the foreseeable time.

Nevertheless, I have managed to gather working experiences in a variety of industries, roles in several forms or organizations and entities incl. Fortune 500 multinationals, design and research institute, private enterprises and more. I have partly achieved what I have planned for career – to work as in many firms and organizations in differing forms as possible. That goal was basically realized.

Phase III Live at Ease (2005 to Now, age 42 to eternity)

And I am getting older as well. At the age of 42 or in 2005, I was extremely despaired by my efforts in business and with the age I am tired of ambition and whatsoever, and determined not to pursue after any significant business and have also worked out my complete plan for life, academic studies, career and others for the rest of life, where I decided not to go after big money, big business, high position, more friends, but excellent health, and closer relations with my parents. Academically I am still ambitious, and try to do something. And considering the hardship in doing business in China, I have also decided to grasp a job somewhere, this is while I have spent soooooooooooooooooooooo much time and efforts in writing this and the other resumes.

To conclude, I find myself quite vacant with

retrospection of my past. I have only realized a small part of my dream, but failed most other goals. Shall I end my life and career in this way? No, I'm determined to do something useful, to me and to the human kind over the next decades.

10. Lost Chances – or rather Lost Life

I used to have met with many opportunities either in academic, profession or private life.

With regards to academic, I have given up doctoral studies in a number of European and North American universities due to the private life arrangement, when I was engaged with a girl from Taiwan, because she could speak neither English, nor French nor Deutsch, and I have got a job in Taiwan (a Bechtel-Taiwan Joint venture) to unite with her but soon after she kicked me off..

And to take care of my parents, I cannot leave China and stay in a city close to my hometown, where my parents live. Here in Hangzhou, there are barely opportunities in business. It is not an internationally recognized metropolis, few international known companies come to Hangzhou for business, and local businesses are concentrated on light industry, textile, some IT, and tourism, few in the power industry.

There were many many cases where I sacrificed private arrangement to career or business development.

- ◆ I come from an old family with long tradition and good education in a small rural town of Zhejiang province, China.
- ◆ But I was able to go to one of the most prestigious universities in China, and after graduation
- ◆ I was able to work at some of the best organizations, institutions and corporations of the world, and
- ◆ won many great opportunities in the academia, business and politics.

And if I have not sacrificed my entire myself

- ◆ for my parents,
- ◆ for my love,
- ◆ for my faith in truth and
- ◆ a number of other reasons in the past
 - over 20 years now, I could have made much greater achievements now in any areas –
- ◆ academia,
- ◆ business and also
- ◆ politics as well.

For example:

FOR MY PARENTS

My parents are always

- ◆ at the center of all of my thoughts, dreams, mission, plan, aim and

- ◆ purpose of life, career, passion and everything.

My lifetime goal is simple – to accompany and to take care of them at their old age.

My parents have drawn much of my attention and energy ever since my young age when I was still a university student till now.

For this I have to stay in China as explained below:

- ◆ I cannot leave my dear parents, therefore I did not try to leave China, as I cannot live too far distant away from them. That's why I didn't try to move to other countries, although I have had plenty of chances with my education and language skills, which is very rare and unique.
- ◆ That's why I turned back from Canton to Shanghai in 1994 and from Beijing to Shanghai again in 2000 and finally from Shanghai to Hangzhou in 2001, which is now the biggest city closest to my parents.
- ◆ For these I've given up my career in more opportunistic cities like Shanghai, Beijing, New York or Paris, to name a few.

FOR LOVE

I should be among the forerunner scientists if I didn't give up the opportunities given to me over the past. I was ready to pursue my Ph.D. degrees in some of the most prestigious universities in the world incl.

- ◆ Université de Pierre et Marie Curie in Paris (PhD for surface chemistry, 1991),
- ◆ Université de Provence (PhD for surface chemistry, 1991),
- ◆ University of Glasgow (PhD for gas turbine combustion research, 1991),
- ◆ Université Laval (mechanical engineering, 1991, Canada),
- ◆ Universität Gesamthochschule Essen (mechanical engineering, Germany, 1991), etc

only to give up due to an engagement with a girl from Taiwan, Republic of China,

- ◆ who spoke none of the languages of the countries these universities are located, and
- ◆ who has also brought police suspect to me because of the frequent cross-strait communications between her in Taizhong and me at Daya Bay Nuclear Power Station (1990-1992).

My ex-wife has also damaged my career in one way or other.

- ◆ For example when she and I was having fighting at home, I have to stay with her instead going to the company where there was an important event, where I can possibly get known with the then French President.
- ◆ But at that time I considered my quarreling wife was much more important than the French or any other president.
- ◆ And more harms have been exerted my ex-wife to my career in other companies too.

POLITIC REASONS

The Ministry:

- ◆ I have given up my political career at the Chinese Central Government (Ministry of Machine Industry) in the mid 80's, also because of my refusal to collaborate with the corrupt and totalitarian government of China.
- ◆ I used to be a highly expected staff of the Ministry in Beijing when I was hardly 20 years old.
- ◆ If I did subject to the communist ideology, then I could be promoted to the top class officials in the central government after 26 years of work since 1983.

Business:

- ◆ If I don't mind the corrupt system in China, I would have developed a large business in whatever areas and earn big money.
- ◆ I have also fought for freedom and democracy, and for that reason I have lost chances to win government relations and economic benefits since long.

Solar:

- ◆ I could also have been a very successful entrepreneur in the solar business if I were willing to operate a big business,
- ◆ but I didn't want to, because by doing so I am also collaborating with the corrupt officials and the systems.
- ◆ At times of solar boom I was able to secure solar orders from Europe worth dozens of millions of EURO.
- ◆ Nevertheless, I have successfully developed my solar portal,
- ◆ won popularity among international solar communities.
- ◆ My ChinaSolar and ChinaPower reporting was accepted by some of the multinationals such as Bayer, Saint Gobaint and Mannesmann.

I have also many other business chances but given up for the same reason.

OTHER REASONS

I've also changed my career plan just for some ironical reasons.

Harvard

- ◆ when I was ready to go to Harvard for a MPA studies in 1996,
- ◆ my then boss told me to stay in his company,
- ◆ he said the chance at Alstom is more important than the studies at Harvard.
- ◆ I accepted his argument and stopped my study plan at Harvard.

China solar portal:

- ◆ in 2003-2005 my China solar portal www.solaires.com has won popularity among the international solar communities and
- ◆ once a British investor wanted to acquire it at a price of US 15 million but
- ◆ I've rejected the acquisition motive because
- ◆ I thought it was part of my life (life is invaluable and hence cannot be sold out) and
- ◆ 15 million US was considered as too low (I've estimated it at over 100 million).

- ◆ Unfortunately due to the more and more stricter restrictions and controls of the Internet imposed by the Chinese communist regime, I was so angry that I have to abandon this valuable solar portal of China.

Jobs with High Salaries:

- ◆ at times when I was running my solar business there were several job offers with 7-digit salaries
- ◆ I've just turned them down because
- ◆ I thought I was able to easily and comfortably earn much more handsome money with my solar and any others.

Who knows what other great chances I've lost.

- ◆ I've been memorizing the above only over the last 3 to 4 years, when my career and life seems stagnating.
- ◆ Earlier I've never realized how many great opportunities I have rejected and thus my fate is completely changed, and
- ◆ the influence is so big that now I have to live a life completely out of my own society.
- ◆ That is, now I have to live like a low class man.
- ◆ Before I was the social elite among the few best respected in China.

20. My Dreams

It is simply unbelievable and remarkable that I am making so many dreams where some of the most best known people are appearing in my dreams.

Since the death of my father in November 2006, I dream of him at least every week.

Then afterwards, since June 2007, I have been dreaming of political, business and scientific leaders of the world very often, such as Bill Gates, Hu Jintao (China's President), Wen Jiabao (Chinese Premiere), British Queen, British Prime Minister and others... In fact, I never think of any political leaders, or businessmen during the day, because they are not of my favored people. On contrary these are the people I very much dislike, or even hate to extreme, because they are great criminals to the nations and the people and to GOD as well. They are liars, evil-doers, cheaters and all kinds of criminals (without these personalities they cannot climb to the hierarchy of the political machines and amass huge wealth - behind every huge wealth there is a great crime as Belzac once put it – therefore I never favor any of them, particularly those of China). Of course I am dreaming of becoming a great scientist – however, I very seldom make such dream – only once with Stephen Hawking and Albert Einstein.

I've also seen Jesus Christ once in my dream around September 2009.

Due to so many repetitive dreams, I have to decide to make some records of the important ones. The following are the dream records since September 2007, where there was an (8 months) interruption between end December 2007 and August 2008, not meaning that there were no similar dreams during this time period, just because I didn't want to follow the recording because they were too many. Dreams with presence of my father were dropped because there are simply too many, as with those of my mother.

All dreams occurred at nights except mentioned otherwise.

I have inquired by several people about the meaning of my dreams, but none can give me satisfactory answers. Some suggest that GOD calls me to get out of the seclusion and join the Hu government, or at least make my own business or whatever enterprises to serve the nation or the world. GOD is reflected in the Bible and many other scriptures and is being discovered by human kind of generations and generations of all cultures, nations and peoples.

It has been my firm belief in freedom, democracy and justice ever since I was a little boy. I prefer to enjoy a free life than bounded to anyone. For that I have paid huge price – isolation, misunderstanding, impoverishment, punishment and others. I think only a true free and democratic society can guarantee the social and economic development in the sense of GOD, if it really exists.

I used to go to church 2004-2006 but refrained from that practices because I found the churches are just some religious rituals, there you can find no true love, faith, truth and justice.

The bible itself is confusing. The GOD it describes is in very conflict with that I find in real life. The world does not run as the GOD in Bible says and GOD itself is different from each other and from the real life.

I have concluded that truth and laws are just the results of social fighting with the winning sides to determine the laws of society, and they are historically different. There are no absolute truth at all. There are also perhaps different laws governing the nature, the universe and the human society.

Jesus Christ can not save the people. He himself did not exist at all, and cannot be the sole son of the GOD.

As a Christian I have devoted quite a lot of time in Gospel missionary, studies several language versions of the Bible (English, French, German and Chinese of course), participated in church services, visited patients of all kinds, helped the maintenance of the church building esp. for the cleaning and audio/video systems, translated languages etc. I am attached to the Seventh Day Adventists Church here in Hangzhou.

22.SPORTS & HEALTH

I Do Sports Everyday

I will keep exercising to the extremity – as much as possible. At the moment the main sport is mountain climbing. Plus morning, and evening fitness.

I will keep my vegetarian diet, stay away from fat and high calories.

I will endeavor to make myself as strong as possible, even at the cost of anything else such as job and money.

Introduction

Over the past years I've been able to keep myself basically in a healthy status, exercised regularly – every day during the school and university days and almost regularly since graduation over the past 23 years or so. And since 2002, I have been keeping climbing mountains every day here in Hangzhou to refresh myself.

And now I spend more than 3 hours a day on sport or exercises, incl. 45 min. morning walking or biking, 1.5 mountain climbing in the afternoon and another 45 min. evening exercise of fitness devices outdoors. Occasionally I also participate in Alpinist group's activities.

My ideal sport time allocation is 8 hours a day!

I have also kept a good diet habitat, never eat too much fat or too high calories. Basically I am a vegetarian.

Of course over the time some chronic illnesses occurred such as throat sore and stomach pain sometimes. I am combating to eliminate these illnesses in a year or two.

Mountain Climbing

Every day I have been spending about 1.5 hours on the mountains to inhale fresh air, to listen to the music of birds and to smell the soil, leaves and to touch the Nature. It's the greatest time of the day. I can't imagine to time without the mountains.

I have been also a member of the local Alpinist Group freely organized.

About 1.5 hours each everyday.

I have also learned table tennis, volley ball and other sports like others, but seldom practiced since graduation.

I Care for My Parents as my Priority No. 1 I Hate Politics and Communism

I have been constantly visiting my parents, pay tributes to them, take care of their needs and health. I am very close and kin to my parents just like when I was a child. I love them very much, more than all the world together. They are my all, my center of attention and my heart.

My social responsibility used to be great. I've tried to work in the political center of the country, submitted reform program, participated in democratic movement, worked out my own conception of democracy and governance, which is different from any existing system on the planet.

I am also a responsible person to my teachers, paid frequent visits to them after leaving the schools, and also tried to keep a good relations with my classmates.

24.1.Introduction

Job and working are not the entirety of my life, as I said before, it's among the least important subjects of my life, instead.

As I traditional and conservative Chinese intellectual, I consider myself obligatory to contribute to the wellness of the society and the well being of the people, therefore I have participated and sometimes even initiated several political movements, which were aimed to improve the political governance and social harmony. I used to develop myself to a political leader, especially at time of the 80's when I just went out of the university and when I was working at the Ministry in Beijing.

I am also responsible and obligatory to take care of my parents, who are aging now.

I am also obliged to help my sisters and brothers and their families with my capacity in case of needs.

I shall keep constant contacts with my three-levels of relatives – those of my grand parents, those of my parents and those of my brothers and sisters with one form or other. They are most residing in my hometown or nearby.

Of course, I have to serve many of my friends, my former teachers, colleges etc.

And my of my countrymen, neighbors are very much kind to me, I shall also not forget them.

And if possible, I shall endeavor to help the poor, the disabled, the ill, the weak, etc to survive.

I have a lot of social obligations and responsibility.

24.2. Parents and My Family

I was born in a rural family in a small village of about 1000 people (and now about 10,000). My parents are peasants, worked extremely hard to nourish our four kids. They are the kindest persons of the world and all of ambition, enthusiasm and force come from them, from the wish to provide them with a happy life.

My father died last year at age of 74, leaving my mother in my hometown, some 80 km north to Hangzhou. She is my loveliest person in the world. For her and for my parents, I have given up my business and career opportunities in other cities and countries since a dozen of years.

24.3. My Own Family

Of course, I won't stay alone for ever. Instead I have my plan for marriage – and the future family.

24.4. Politics

This includes studies of political literature and participation in reform engagement. I have carefully studies the political and government systems of the US. Japan and several other countries and has figured out my own conception of democratic governance, which is fairly different from any systems now alive in the world.

24.5. Music

I used to listen to classic music esp. the violin pieces every day when studying postgraduate at Tongji Uni,m and used to go to the concert almost every week at Shanghai Concert at Yanan Dong Lu. It was the great time. I have also enjoyed the violin playing for two years, but my techniques remained very primitive.

25. WHY IN HANGZHOU?

In 2001 I came to Hangzhou, not to start my ambitious career in any of the areas of commerce, politics or academics, but to take care of my parents, who live in the suburban village of the nearby city of Huzhou, about 70 km north to Hangzhou, the capital city of Zhejiang province.

I have been worrying about their health and aging since very long, and I thought my career in China is finished and nothing to me is more important than to take care of my dearest people in the world, therefore it's the only choice to me to come close to my parents, so that they may feel safer.

However, the situation in China has been worsening to such a degree that I have no chance to settle down here comfortably because of the exuberantly high prices of houses, medical expenses, schooling and other living costs, that continuing to stay here is no more possible.

On the other hand, because of the expensive cost of operating a business and the complexity to run a company in a corrupted environment, my business development plan cannot be achieved without a compromise with the corrupted social and political regime. As a result, even my daily life is jeopardized.

26. WHY IN CHINA NOW - FOR MY PARENTS

Although I've plenty of opportunities to pursue

- ◆ PhD studies, or
- ◆ researches, or
- ◆ business, or
- ◆ immigration etc)

outside China in the past, but I've never thought of leaving China because

- ◆ first, I thought China will eventually become a free country and thus there is no reason to leave China and
- ◆ I care for my parents very much so that I am not willing to stay too far away from them.

My parents are always at the center of all of my thoughts, and I have always been considering to take care of them at their old ages.

My lifetime goal is simple – to accompany and to take care of them at their old age.

My parents have drawn much of my attention and energy ever since my young age when I was still a university student till now.

For this I have to stay in China as explained below:

- ◆ I cannot leave my dear parents, therefore I did not try to leave China, as I cannot live too far distant away from them. That's why I didn't try to move to other countries, although I have had plenty of chances with my education and language skills, which is very rare and unique.
- ◆ That's why I turned back from Canton to Shanghai in 1994 and from Beijing to Shanghai again in 2000 and finally from Shanghai to Hangzhou in 2001, which is now the biggest city closest to my parents.
- ◆ For these I've given up my career in more opportunistic cities like Shanghai, Beijing, New York or Paris, to name a few.

27. WHAT CAN I DO IN CHINA???

Business: I would have developed a large business in whatever areas and earn big money, If I don't mind the corrupt system in China, and if I have not fought for freedom, only to have lost chances to win government relations and economic benefits since long. Because I hate communism and I desire of freedom, but the communists deprive me of all rights, freedom and security. I don't want enrich them using my expertise, therefore, in China I won't develop a business large enough to nourish them and extend the life of the regime.

At times of solar boom I was able to secure solar orders from Europe worth dozens of millions of EURO, but instead of earning big money, I chose to reject these orders so that I may not be obliged to cooperate with the regime. .

Solar: I could also have been a very successful entrepreneur in the solar business if I were willing to operate a big business, but I didn't want to, because by doing so I am also collaborating with the corrupt officials and the systems. At times of solar boom I was able to secure solar orders from Europe worth dozens of millions of EURO. Nevertheless, I have successfully developed my solar portal, won popularity among international solar communities. My ChinaSolar and ChinaPower reporting was accepted by some of the multinationals such as Bayer, Saint Gobaint and Mannesmann.

Developed a solar web portal of www.solaires.com which won popularity in the industry worldwide and was quoted by US DOE/NREL, ISES, JPMorgan, and other well-known industry players, investment banks and consultants. Unfortunately due to the more and more strict restrictions and controls of the Internet imposed by the Chinese regime, I was so angry that I have to abandon this valuable solar portal of China, which proved to be detrimental to my business and caused huge economical and image losses. Unless these restrictive measures are not lifted, I will never register a new domain or operate a website. Hence so far I have no web presence since 2006 and my business has been stagnating ever since.

Politics: In fact, I could be promoted to a high ranking official of the Chinese government if I did not leave the Ministry of Machine Industry of China in 1986 when I was only 23 years old. But now first, I won't indulge myself in politics, therefore becoming an office of the systems is also not my plan, although it was my ambition to devote my life to the well-being of the motherland China, for this I've studied very hard the world politics, already in the early 1980's when I was working at the Ministry of Machinery of China, and have figured out a political restructuring idea. But now the system is completely irreversible towards decay and destruction, thus it is not my mission to participate in any kind of salvage plan, because I see China has forever lost its chance in being part of the modern civilization after the 1989 massacre and thus China will be forever ruled under dictatorship, because it is determined by the nature of its people. 1989 was the year when the entire world has basically fulfilled a democratization movement and thus has entered an entirely new era. Few have, even today, realized the importance of that year to the development of

the human being on the earth.

Academia:

Tsinghua University: And lately in May 2009, I have turned down a visiting scholar offer to Tsinghua University by a CAS Academician for thermodynamics research in December 2008, because, 1) Beijing is too far away from my mother in Zhejiang, 2) Beijing is not the city I like, 3) I have no intention to continue my thermodynamics as I have changed my interests to Internet security for the battle against censorship imposed by the government sometime in March 2009, 4) I fear that the corrupt academic system will only destroy my competence, independence and freedom of research etc. I'm of the opinion that there are no chances to win academic excellence under the current system.

And a career in the academia is no way! The degree of corruption in this part of the society is no less than anywhere else – even worse. Universities are running exactly like any other commercial entities and administrative forces and ranks determine all, not your scientific talent, diligence and morality. Forget it!

Others:

I was once ready to accept a job offer from ABB China, but my rejection of a lunch with the interviewing officer has turned this chance to zero, because I told him my wife was waiting outside. This answer has apparently angered him and thus the job was cancelled.

And considering all the above, what can I do in China?

28. THE ECONOMIC STATUS

In China, I have no chance to survive, as

The housing prices are among the highest in the world, for example here in downtown Hangzhou, an apartment will cost you RMB 70000 m², and an average employee earns only about RMB 2000 a month and he has no welfare at all (unlike western society China does not provide reasonable assurance to its citizens), therefore he needs to work for hundreds of years to buy such an apartment without other spending – and the prices are still rising at a rate over 10% a year!

Medicare: it is sure one of the highest in the world and a simple flu will cost us hundreds of RMB and a small surgery tens of thousands and a major operation even a million. Chinese people have to pay hospitalization costs all on their own and these are incredibly expensive.

Studies: Chinese people are also paying some of the highest prices not only for higher education but also for kindergarten, primary and secondary schools. They are well beyond the financial capacity of the most of the Chinese people.

China's education cost are also among the highest in the world. It is said a farmer has to work and save more than 30 years to provide money for his son or daughter to enter university. Likewise, education cost in elementary, secondary schools are even higher than high education. China does not provide free education for its children.

Most other commodities are also priced higher than anywhere else.

Therefore living in China is a struggle for survival. There is no way out – no guarantee of a home, no guarantee of a medical treatment and no guarantee of an affordable education.

There are many many other weird things happening here in China. Air, water, food are all polluted and poisoned. Most products are of very low quality and fakes. People cheat each other. Chinese don't respect each other, they don't know how to behave in the public. Etc etc.

29. HUKOU PROBLEM – ALSO POLITICAL SYSTEM

RELATED

- ◆ Hukou means literally number of household but actually it is a system of population control and is a special problem in China, there is no English equivalence.
- ◆ Simply put, it is a system to restrain Chinese people to a small region where they are allowed to work and move.
- ◆ Therefore with this system movement in the country is extremely difficult, and
- ◆ doing business within this system is also difficult.

When I was in Shanghai in 1999 and 2000, I wanted to open my own business,

- ◆ but I have to go to Guangzhou to get all the licensees and certificates prepared where my Hukou was registered.
- ◆ Guangzhou is 1400 km distant from Shanghai and
- ◆ traveling several times between the two cities would involve huge money and of course lots of time.
- ◆ Therefore I have to give up the idea to own my own company.
- ◆ Without my own company I was barely able to develop my business in any sense.
- ◆ I moved later to Hangzhou because of one of them problems was this Hukou issue.
- ◆ But it was only found out the Hangzhou government was cheating us all.

30. VOICE PROBLEM

- ◆ In early 1996 my voice was damaged,
- ◆ otherwise I was ready to switch to GE Shanghai as a regional manager and
- ◆ my career was going up like a rocket at that time.
- ◆ There was no explanation as to how the voice cord was damaged,
- ◆ but for sure this has prevented my career from further development,
- ◆ though I still have managed to get jobs at Alstom and Babcock,
- ◆ but the situation in general was pessimistic,
- ◆ as I was having extreme difficulty communicating with others,
- ◆ and even my private life was affected greatly.
- ◆ This illness has been fatal until a few years ago.

31. Political Persecution

I have been suffering continual political persecution and supervision due to

- ◆ my political opinion in general and
- ◆ my active involvement in the 1989's student-lead democratic movement around June 4, 1989, summarized as below:

Interrogation and Torture 1991-1993

- ◆ Some time in 1992, I was interrogated by the police for my participation in the 1989 student democratic movement, as I was an employee of a Siemens Shenzhen subsidiary.
- ◆ I was severely tortured in the midnight some days later after the interrogation.
- ◆ It demonstrated that they were still tracing me three years after.
- ◆ To quote, I was the head of the propaganda team of the postgraduate club of Tongji University during the student movement, which was organized voluntarily.
- ◆ But I was not among the highest leadership.
- ◆ And after the movement I also have not been involving in any other types of anti-government activities.

The police have also secretly investigated into my case by

- ◆ my school teachers,
- ◆ my classmates,
- ◆ my colleagues and
- ◆ my family

for my participation in the movement during the time shortly after 1989, as told years later by them.

They have also investigated into my case when

- ◆ I was engaged with a girlfriend of Taiwan, at time when I was in Shenzhen (1990-1994).
- ◆ They guessed her as a spy from Taiwan.

These investigations and interrogations

- ◆ have severely damaged my relations with my close friends, colleagues and teachers,
- ◆ as they tried to keep me distant as possible as they could.
- ◆ And the high school where I attended slashed my name from its enrolment list,
- ◆ as did Tongji University where I obtained both my bachelor and mater degrees.

People looked at me differently.

My image was greatly damaged too.

Monitoring of my Telecommunications

Over the years I've been one of the monitoring targets of the Chinese security agents, because of my anti-communist speeches and ideas.

All of my communications are strictly monitored, once I left the last employer (Deutsche Babcock in Beijing) in 1999, as I have lost my protection from the multinationals.

For example,

- ◆ almost all my postal communications are brutally spied;
- ◆ all my postal mails are torn off to some degree before reaching me,
- ◆ particularly those from overseas,
- ◆ although all of them are of
 - business,
 - academic or
 - private nature.
- ◆ Some of my critical mails have never reached the recipients.
- ◆ But I can do nothing to claim anyone for damage or compensation.

Many times my telephone lines seem to be overheard and tapped, as judged from the strange voice quality.

Many times people complain to be unable to dial up my telephone or lines are easily broken or of very bad quality.

Monitoring of my Internet Activities

My online activities are being closely monitored.

- ◆ In at least two instances, the online police has tried to install LAN monitoring software into my computer remotely, which was captured by my firewalls, but I never know whether or not they have successfully installed some other tools into my computer without my awareness.
- ◆ There are numerous intrusion attempts from local ISP (who cooperate with police on the Web) in an intention to manipulate my computer.
- ◆ Recently my Internet connection seems to be disabled after 22:00 pm.

I am heavily dependent on the Internet for my business, research and communications.

- ◆ However, it is becoming more and more troublesome in using the Internet services.
- ◆ Stricter and stricter controls are being taken.
- ◆ The censorship system is so powerful that most of my time is consumed in getting out of the censoring
- ◆ so that my working and learning efficiencies are greatly reduced to a fraction.
- ◆ Searching the Web through Google.com will be brutally shut down or
- ◆ the searching results will be redirected by the Net police only after a dozen of pages are opened.

Apart from restrictions to web browsing,

- ◆ restrictions are also being imposed on the use of other web applications,

- ◆ which shall be opened otherwise,
- ◆ for I am in a private home-based LAN, not in a corporate LAN.
- ◆ Many web functionalities are deactivated once the government finds them as “sensitive”.
- ◆ To find the right information I need to spend many times more efforts compared to an uncensored one.

All state-of-the-art bypassing and anti-censoring/filtering technologies, software, systems and methods seem to be handicapped in front of the powerful Great Firewall of China.

I feel no safety while online.

All my mouse clicks might subject to close scrutiny of the Net police.

Loss of Privacy, Safety and Security – in Real Life as on the Cyberspace

Now, I still feel unsafe, uncertain, whether online or in actual life.

I never know whether my private data in my computer are being stolen away by the police and

- ◆ used for purpose I never know, incl. my sensitive
 - financial,
 - business and
 - personal data.
- ◆ Once turned on, my computer and my entire online and offline activities are under the eyes of the communist systems,
- ◆ as the Internet in China is actually in a big LAN,
- ◆ everybody is under the strict control of the LAN Master.

I also don't know whether or not *the police and security authorities might come to arrest me any time* for reasons you may laugh at.

My safety, security and privacy in general and on the Internet in particular cannot be protected and guaranteed while in China.

Loss of Freedom & Rights as a Human

Living in Communist-ruled China I feel depressing and oppressed.

I have no way to do my job, studies and researches normally under such hash conditions.

Here I feel stuffed:

- ◆ no freedom of thinking,
- ◆ no freedom of speech and expression,
- ◆ no freedom of publishing,
- ◆ no freedom of information,
- ◆ no freedom of demonstration and strike,
- ◆ no freedom of moving and resettlement,

- ◆ no freedom of ... - everything.

I've

- ◆ no right to elect our own government officials,
- ◆ no rights to participate in politics,
- ◆ no rights to join the policy making process,
- ◆ no rights of organizing or participating in my own interests groups and parties,
- ◆ no saying in everything impacting on my
 - life,
 - business,
 - studies and
 - career...

I feel I am a slave and jailed for lifelong here in PRC.

The situation is so unbearable and annoying that the only option is to leave the country.
